Family Practice – No Surgery

- Aspirations of cyst of breast
- Biopsies of lesions limited to the mucous membranes of the nose, mouth, Vagina, uterine cervix and rectum
- Bone marrow biopsy
- Chemotherapy (under the direction of an Oncologist)
- Fine needle aspirations
- Immobilization, excluding casting, or non-displaced fractures
- Incising, excising, and/or suturing, for purpose of biopsy or otherwise, lesions limited to the skin and immediate subcutaneous tissue
- Needle penetration of the skin and blood vessels
- Paracentesis
- Thoracentesis

- All Family Practice – no surgery procedures
- Assisting in surgery

- Closed reduction of simple fractures
- Colonoscopy (up to 65 centimeters, with or without IV Sedation)
- Culdocentesis
- Dilation and Curettage
- Hemiorrhaphy
- Insertion of IUD
- Myringotomies
- Nasal polypectomy
- Office Gynecology
- Other minor office procedures
- Therapeutic abortion (1st trimester)
- Vasectomy

- All Family Practice – no surgery and minor surgery procedures
- Analgesia, I.V. for surgical or other procedures
- Anal fistulectomies
- Appendectomy
- A & P Repair
- Cholecystectomies
- Ectopic pregnancy
- Elective cardioversion
- Exchange transfusions
- Hemorrhoidectomy
- Hydrocelectomy
- Hysterectomy, vaginal abdominal
- Laparoscopy
- Oophorectomy
- Orchidectomy
- Salpingectomy
- Scalene Node biopsy
- Tendon, repair
- Tonsillectomy
- Therapeutic abortion (up to 16 weeks)
